Due to a combination of low numbers in autumn 2020 & a cold, wet spring 2021, butterfly populations were depleted at the start of the season. This situation, not helped by a dry spell hindering food-plant availability, persisted with little or no recovery in number or diversity. So, overall, a disappointing year. Species highlighted illustrate 4 groups:
